



THE PATTULLO BRIDGE.

Total length, including approaches, 7,800 feet; width, 46 feet, providing lanes for vehicular traffic and a 6-foot sidewalk. ¶ Shipping channel, 438 feet; vertical clearance, 150 feet; main piers, 160 feet from river-bed to bridgeseat. ¶ Illuminated by the most modern type of lighting; provides for all future requirements of traffic loading. ¶ The construction of this bridge entailed the use of 5,300 tons of structural steel, 1,600 tons of reinforcing steel, 62,000 cubic yards of concrete, 180,000 cubic yards of earth excavation, 100,000 barrels of cement, and 2,000,000 board-feet of timber.
