GETTING AROUND METRO VANCOUVER

- Plan your trip. Use Google Maps or visit translink.ca/worldcupvan.
- Leave a little extra time on busy days. Large crowds, road closures, and special events may affect travel near venues. Beat the crowds and make more of your day with exclusive transit offers across Metro Vancouver.
- Check alerts before you head out. Get real-time updates at translink.ca/alerts.
- Flying in? Take the Canada Line from YVR to downtown in under 30 minutes.



FIFA WORLD CUP 2026™ VANCOUVER TRAVEL TIPS

Check your route before you go — access may change on match and event days.

Heading to BC Place Vancouver

- Main Street–Science World Station is the best way to access BC Place Vancouver on match days. Customers should exit there and follow the City of Vancouver’s Last Mile pedestrian route along the False Creek waterfront to the stadium.
- Stadium–Chinatown and Yaletown–Roundhouse stations will remain open, but access to BC Place Vancouver from these stations will be limited.

Heading to the FIFA Fan Festival™ Vancouver

We’re increasing bus service to help fans get to and from the FIFA Fan Festival™ Vancouver, located within the PNE Grounds at Hastings Park, including a dedicated shuttle connecting people to both the Expo and Millennium SkyTrain lines.

Late-night trips

Heading home after a match or event? Check the last train and bus times before you travel.

Travelling with kids?

- Take a photo of your child before you go, so you have a current picture of what they’re wearing.
- Pick a meeting spot before you travel.
- Make sure children know your name and phone number or keep the information on your child with a label tag or pocket note.
- If you get separated, notify staff immediately — we’re here to help.
- Remember, kids 12 & under ride for free!



HOW TO PAY YOUR FARE

Fastest & easiest: Tap to Pay

- Skip the ticket machine – tap your contactless credit card, Interac Debit, Apple Pay or Google Pay at the faregate to purchase your fare*.
- Each rider must use a separate card or device.

When to tap

- Bus – Tap once when boarding.
- SkyTrain, SeaBus & West Coast Express – Tap in at the start of your trip. Tap out at the end.

Good to know

- Kids 12 & under ride free.
- Prefer a ticket? Buy a Compass Ticket at SkyTrain station vending machines. If you’re travelling on a busy day, consider purchasing your return ticket in advance to save time later.
- Please pay your fare before travelling. Fare checks may take place, and travelling without valid fare may result in a fine up to \$173.

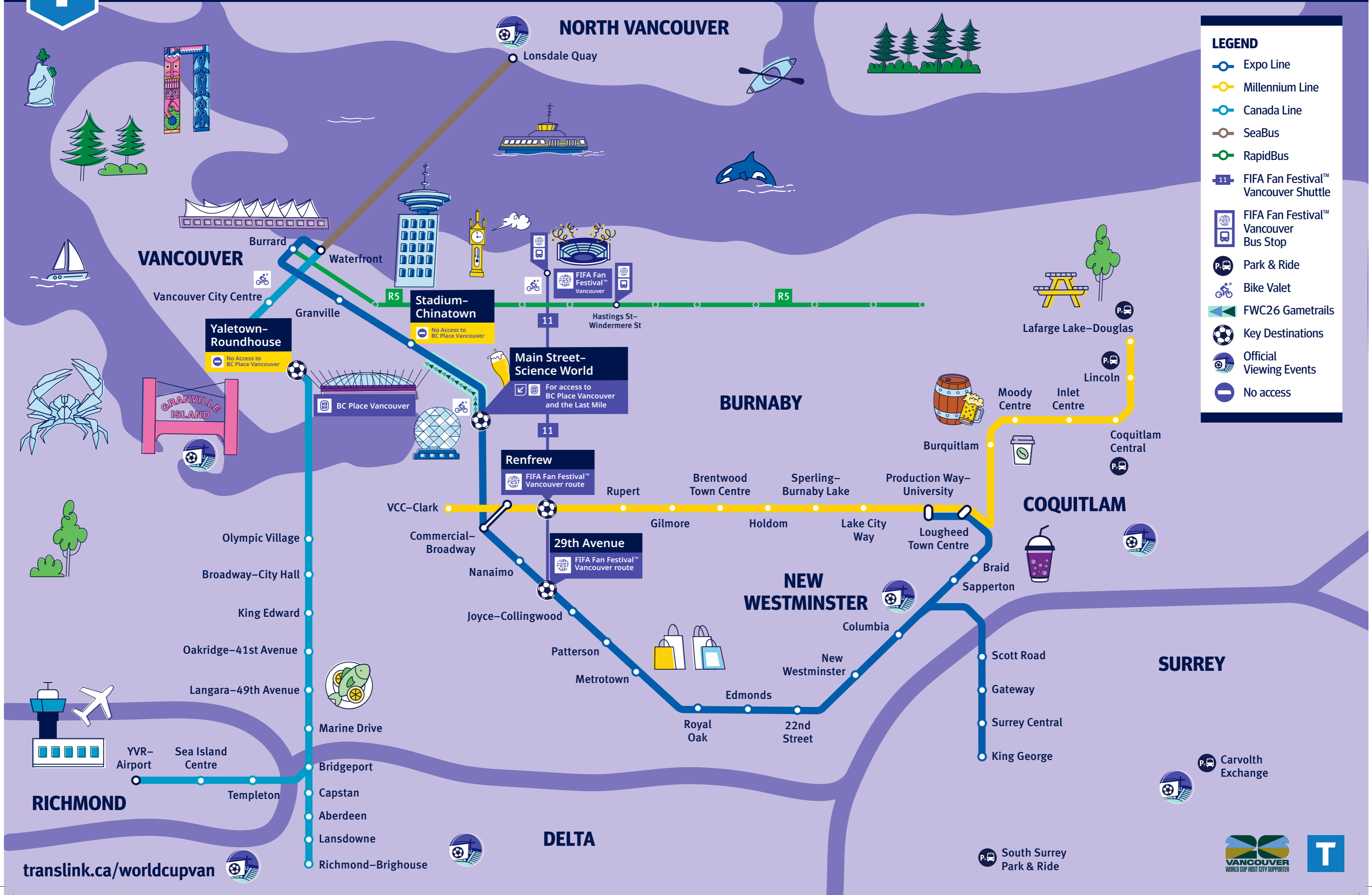
