InTransitBC is inviting the public for a sneak peek inside Lansdowne Station on Thursday, April 9, 2009, between the hours of 4:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m. This is the first of four public open houses along the Canada Line route to view the inside of Canada Line stations and trains, and to learn more about how public feedback was used throughout the design and construction stages of the project.

It is important to note that the Lansdowne Station area continues to be an active construction site, and the public should dress accordingly for this indoor/outdoor event. Wearing comfortable, casual and warm clothing, and flat closed-toe shoes, is highly recommended. The public must adhere to all safety guidelines and use extra care and attention while onsite.



Lansdowne Station is located on No. 3 Road at Lansdowne Road in Richmond. Access for persons with disabilities will be provided in the station, and parking for the disabled will be available at the southeast side of the station. General onsite parking for this event is also located at the southeast side of the station provided by Lansdowne Mall.
