How to Participate

DETAILS OF TRANSLINK'S I LOVE TRANSIT CAMP 2019 CONTEST

TransLink's I Love Transit Camp 2020 (the "Camp") will be held on a to be decided date during the 2020-21 school year. The Contest is open to students attending school in Metro Vancouver, and in kindergarten through twelve as of September 1, 2020. Submissions will be accepted by teachers on behalf of their class.

The class selected as the winner of the Contest, and their teachers and/or chaperones, will win a visit from a TransLink bus to their school. The Camp will be provided at no cost to the participants, and lunch and snacks will be provided. Further details will be provided to the Camp participants prior to the date.

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for TransLink's Camp, teachers entering their class in the Contest must:

- (a) be a legal resident of the Province of British Columbia; and
- (b) be teaching a class that is in kindergarten through Grade 12 as of September 1, 2020 at a public or independent school within Metro Vancouver.

HOW TO PARTICIPATE

To participate, the teacher of the class wishing to enter the Contest must submit a written article (of between 150–250 words or less) describing what their class's ideas are on how we can be kind, calm and safe on transit as we move forward, getting back into the swing of things and return back to school.. The written article must be prepared as a joint class effort, and can also include a photograph, video, drawing, or other visual element to accompany the written article if desired. The

written article and any other material must be submitted together.

The submission must also include:

- (a) the name of the teacher and the teacher's phone number and email address;
- (b) the school's name, address and district;
- (c) the grade and number of students in the class; and
- (d) how the teacher/class heard about the Contest.

Submissions can be submitted through the online form at <u>http://buzzer.translink.ca/ilovetransit;</u> emailed to <u>thebuzzer@translink.ca</u> with "I Love Transit Camp 2020" in the subject field; or mailed to The Buzzer, c/o Social Media Team, 400 – 287 Nelson's Court, New Westminster, BC, V3L 0E7. Submissions received by any other method will not be accepted. Submissions must be received between 8:00 am on September 8, 2020 and 5:00pm on October 13, 2020. Early and late submissions will not be accepted. Only one submission per class will be accepted, all subsequent submissions will be disqualified.

Each submission must be the property of the class. The school district agrees to indemnify TransLink and its subsidiaries from any and all copyright, trademark or other intellectual property infringement claims or liability which may arise with regard to the class submission.

Submissions must not include content that is unlawful, harmful, vulgar, obscene, hateful, discriminatory, or otherwise objectionable as determined by TransLink, in its sole discretion.

Submissions become the property of TransLink and will not be returned. By submitting a submission for TransLink's Camp, the school district grants TransLink a non-exclusive, worldwide, royalty-free right in perpetuity to use and reproduce the submission in any manner without further permission or remuneration.

SELECTION OF SUCCESSFUL SUBMISSION AND NOTIFICATION

The complete submissions received by the **October 13, 2020** contest deadline will be judged against the following:

- Theme Adherence: Excellent (4 points), Very Good (3 points), Good (2 points) and Fair (1 point);
- Quality of Written Submission: Excellent (4 points), Very Good (3 points), Good (2 points) and Fair (1 point);
- Originality: Excellent (4 points), Very Good (3 points), Good (2 points) and Fair (1 point);
- Creativity: Excellent (4 points), Very Good (3 points), Good (2 points) and Fair (1 point); and
- Overall Impact: Excellent (4 points), Very Good (3 points), Good (2 points) and Fair (1 point).

The winning submission will be given to those who score closest to 20 points. In the event of a tie, the winner will be chosen randomly from the qualified submissions scoring all 20 points.

The teacher of the winning class will be notified by TransLink within 48 hours of the selection via the telephone number provided by the teacher at the time of submission. The teacher of the winning class will be required to acknowledge via email receipt of the notification email. If no response is received by TransLink within two business days of notification, the prize will be forfeited and an alternate class from the remaining eligible submissions will be selected.
